

PRAYERS

722 O Lord, our Savior Jesus Christ, we bow before You and humbly acknowledge our fallen condition, and our need of Your Divine work of redemption; grant to us, O Lord, that which You alone can give, the power to see You in Your Word, and to follow You in the path of Your commandments; for to You belong all the power and the glory forever and ever. Amen.

723 We praise You, O Lord, and magnify Your holy name, because You took upon Yourself a body of flesh and blood, to manifest Your power and to redeem and save the lost; and we pray, O Lord, that You confirm and establish Your work in people's hearts that Your kingdom may prevail on earth and endure forever. Amen.

724 O Lord God of heaven and earth, who from Your infinite love and pity did take on Yourself our fallen nature, and did come to redeem and save: come now, we beseech You, and grant to us the blessings of Your redeeming work that we may bear fruit to You in works of charity and love, through Your mercy, O Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

725 O Lord, our Redeemer and Savior, who in Your infinite mercy did overcome death and hell for us, we beseech You to lead us to fulfill Your redemption in our lives by taking up our cross daily and following You in a life of repentance; strengthen our purpose to put away everything that defiles, or works abomination, or makes a lie; lead us to renounce the lusts of self and the world that we may become worthy of Your kingdom, and give glory to You in a life of eternal use. Amen.

726 O Lord Jesus Christ, on this Your natal day, we pray that You bless the hearing and reading of Your Word. Help us to understand ever more truly the great mercy of Your coming, which is told since ancient times and yet is ever new. Cleanse our hearts, we pray, and make us pure within, that we may worship You in innocence and love, becoming aware of Your near presence in Your glorified Human to uplift and save all who call upon You in sincerity of heart. Amen.

727 We beseech You, O Lord, to order our steps in Your Word, that no iniquity may have dominion over us. Give us strength against our inward foes, and protect us against the powers of darkness. Guard us against the spirit of self-will, pride and vain imagination. Save us from the rejection of Your truth, and from every perverse and sinful thought. From prejudice, blindness and hardness of heart, O Lord, deliver us. Lead us in Your ways and teach us, that not our will may be done but Your will, O Lord, forever. Amen.

O Lord Jesus Christ, in Your second advent You have revealed the secrets **728** of heaven to all who have ears to hear what the Spirit says to the churches. Redeem us, we pray, from the glamour of the world and the love of rule. Open our hearts to the selfless love of serving others, and prepare us in Your good time for a place and a use in Your eternal kingdom in the heavens. Amen.

O Lord, Your Word is a lamp unto our feet and a light unto our path. **729** Help us to read it in a humble spirit, and to seek and find the treasures of heavenly truth which You have laid open at Your second coming. From ourselves we can know nothing of truth, but You can teach us. Bless us with spiritual understanding, intelligence, and wisdom in ever-increasing measure, that we may know You and love Your law and Your way. Amen. *Cf. Psalm 119: 105*

Most merciful Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, who by Your second coming **730** in the power and glory of Your Word did enable us to acknowledge You as the only God of heaven and earth, our Creator and our Redeemer, we pray for the prosperity of Your New Church, now descending from You out of heaven. Dispel the darkness that prevents Your appearing. Open the eyes of the blind and the ears of the deaf, and reveal Yourself to Your creatures as the husband of Your church, the true and only object of her love and worship. And wherever Your church appears on the face of the earth, may she be so led by Your Holy Spirit that all who embrace the Heavenly Doctrines may maintain them in purity of heart and holiness of life, to the glory of Your holy name. Amen.

O Lord, breathe into our hearts, we pray, the love of Your truth, that we **734** may draw near to You and become Your humble servants, obeying Your commandments in simplicity of heart, loving You above all things, and Your

truth for its own sake, that You may enter into us, and dwell in Your own with us forever. Amen.

735 Lord God, You open Your hand and satisfy every living thing; give us, we pray, the bread which comes down from heaven, that we may eat of it and not die. You make the grass to grow for the cattle, and vegetation for the service of humankind, and give to all their daily bread. 736 Grant, O Lord, in Your mercy, that we may see and acknowledge our evils and shun them as sins against You; so shall You create in us a new heart and a new spirit; for You, O Lord, have all power; great are the wonders of Your mercy, and Your truth abides forever. Amen.

737 O Lord, You know the springs of our life; all the thought of our heart is laid open before You; from You no secret is hidden. Enlighten our minds, we beseech You, that we may see and acknowledge our secret sins and open transgressions, and be made pure in heart by Your might and power, O Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

738 O Lord our Father in the heavens, we lift up our eyes to You from whom alone comes our help. Show us Your mercy, we pray, and forgive us our trespasses. Purify our affections that we may willingly refuse the evil and choose the good. Teach us the way of Your commandments, and lead us in it, that we may come at last to the gates of Your heavenly kingdom, and dwell in Your presence forever. Amen.

739 Most merciful Lord, You have all power over hell, and hold it under subjection to Yourself; we pray for Your Divine presence in the hour of temptation, that the hosts of evil may be turned back, and that we may obtain the victory in Your name, and through Your mercy, O Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

740 O Lord God, reveal Your will to us when we reach the crossroads of our lives. Sustain us in our trials and temptations. Hold us up with Your mighty arm, that in our blindness and self-will we may not swerve from the way which You have set for us. Cleanse our hearts and fill us with Your Spirit, that in will and deed we may fulfill the duties of our calling, and learn to become citizens of Your heavenly kingdom. Amen.

741 O Jesus Christ our Lord, help us to love one another as You have loved us, to be merciful as You are merciful, to forgive as You have forgiven, that we may follow You all the days of our life. Amen.

O Lord God of mercy and love, You have given us Your new commandment, that we should love one another as You have loved us; we pray that You bestow on us a mind forgetful of ill will to our neighbor, a conscience free of evil thought or design, and a heart sincere in keeping Your commandments, that mutual love may prevail on earth, and Your heavenly kingdom be established to endure forever.
